

TIP FROM THE PROS

Many golfers around the world understand the value of putting and how it can help your scores. You seldom see the putting green littered with players PRACTICING.

There is a huge difference in putting and PRACTICING putting.

There are two things that have to happen for you to make putts....GOOD PACE AND GOOD LINE. Speed is the most important of these two: If you have good pace, it will leave you a shorter next putt making it less likely to 3 putt. When your pace is good, you will see putts catch the edges of the hole and fall in, instead of lipping out. If you have good pace you will be able to read greens better since the pace is consistent. Players that do not pay attention to pace will hit one putt that goes 6" past the hole and the next one 2 feet past the hole and wonder why the putts reacts differently each time the make a stroke. This inconsistency with pace will lead to missed on putts from all lengths.

When you PRACTICE make sure you set up a drill or practice station that is tailored to either pace or line to improve your putting, NOT just swatting putts around in a circle. If you need help with these drills or to better learn how to practice, call us at 255.7706.

Rules Wizard
