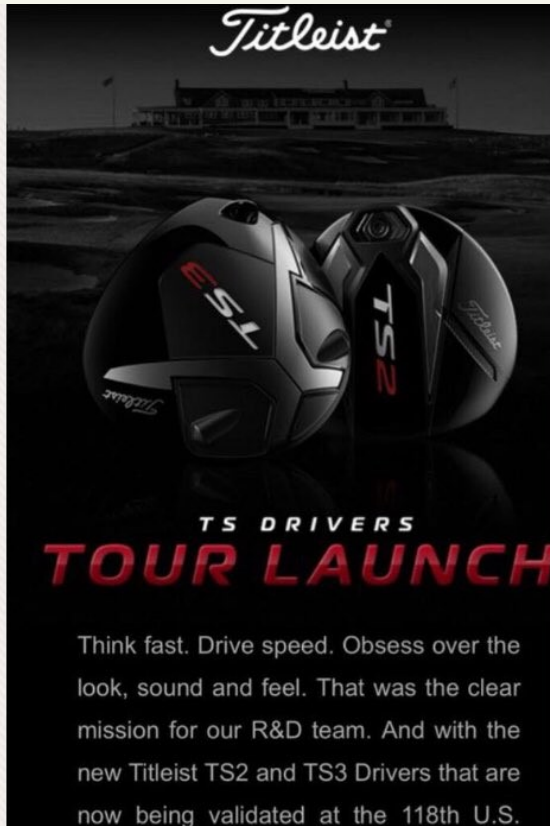

TIPS FROM THE PROS

Every golfer on the planet is searching for consistency. To be consistent, you have to have solid fundamentals. As boring as it sounds, being more consistent is being better before the club ever moves.

In your setup, you need to align your body parallel to the target line and the point the clubface at the target. Anything less than this will require a bad swing to hit the ball on target. If we practice without alignment aids, how do you ever know where you are aimed?

Having good posture allows your body to move more efficiently and keep the club in front of your body longer increasing your chances of repetitively hitting the ball at your target. Make sure your wrists are over the top of your toes and your hips are tilted down. **DO NOT BEND FROM THE WAIST!!!!** When over the ball, you should feel like your belt buckle is pointing at the ground.

Grip is somewhat individual to each player and how you release the club. Even though there are some varying grips out there, to be consistent, every successful player will have their palms facing each other. If you are hitting the ball right, rotate your hands clockwise on the club. If the ball is going left, rotate your hands counter clockwise. Either way make sure, your palms are facing each other to repeat a consistent shot pattern.
