## Superintendent's Corner

We have a busy month planned here at the golf course. The 91<sup>st</sup> Labor Day tournament starts off the month. It is the longest running tournament in Oklahoma. The Ladies Dunkin' Divot is the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of the month. This is our grand ladies event at the club. We will do our best to have the course is tip top shape.

After the Dunkin' Divot we are going to kill #3 green and re-seed it. This process will take 8-10 weeks to make that green brand new and more playable. We have started preparing a temporary green out in the fairway in anticipation of this. The excitement out here at the club is high, knowing the course will be improved greatly. The new green will be the same size and shape as the current green.

In September we over-seed the driving range tees and chipping area with rye grass. The rye stays green in the winter, thus making these areas more playable in winter. I learned early in this business that the best time to seed winter grasses is at the State Fair. It always rains during the state fair. Mark your calendar by it. The fair starts on the 13<sup>th</sup> of September and I bet it rains that morning or during the day. With rain brings cooler temperatures, yet the soil temperatures are high enough to get quick germination of the seed.

As always we are working through some irrigation leaks. A couple of leaks have popped up near the pump station on 15. We have to turn the pumps off to fix these leaks. We need either rain or cool weather to be able to turn off the pumps.

## Tips from the Pros

A carpenter's chalk-line and a CD disc are great putting aids to have in your golf bag. The chalk-line is useful to help you with your alignment and stroke. Find a straight six to ten foot putt on a practice green. Snap a chalk-line from the hole back to desired distance. Put a ball on line and make sure your putter and body are lined up properly. Try to roll the putt right up the chalk-line. Use the CD as a mirror. Lay the disc on the green and place a ball in the hole. Take your stance until your eyes are either directly over the ball or just inside.
